



Chablis -Rosette- 2024

Our terroir....

...Rosette is a locality in Courgis, next to Premier Cru Beauregard.

The vines take root in a deep clay soil resting on the kimmeridgian base, between the northwest facing hills and the valley floor with clay soil.

A gentle and vibrant landscape with walnut trees and preserved surrounding vegetation. The work in the vineyard is done in rhythm of the soil, exclusively to chenillard, in order to respect the structure of the land. Rosette takes its name from this unique place, of which it expresses memory and identity...



The vineyard...

...of Rosette, average aged of 35 years, covers 1,15 hectare. They are cultivated gently, fed by homemade compost, in order to support soil life.

We make a Guyot Poussard soft and gentle pruning, that respects sap flow and the longevity of the vines. Each intervention aims to preserve the natural balance of the vine and its intimate connection with the place that hosts it...

The wine from our vines...

Fermentation starts with a « home-made » starter, based on indigenous yeasts. 90% of this cuvée is aged in concrete tank and 10% in 7-years-old barrels. 11 months later, they are blended in stainless steel tank and they continue to age for another 4 months in order to find the right balance.

We keep intervention to a minimum : the wine is not fined and lightly filtered before bottling.

This is a gourmet wine, with a tangy, fresh and persistent finish, true to the expression of the place.



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
